Concept Note

Since the invasion of Ukraine by the Russian Federation, 100.000s of persons with disabilities have relocated to other European countries; primarily in the countries bordering it. 100.000s more still live in Ukraine, many in dangerous situations and with significant difficulties in moving to safer areas.

NGOs, people and public authorities have been actively working to providing housing and support to persons with disabilities from Ukraine and their families. Yet this is all very new and there is very little sharing of experiences over how this can be done, how to organize the transport, how to cooperate between NGOs and authorities, how to deal with legal issues, and many other issues.

This webinar will aim to share experiences and practices on how to support people with disabilities and their families from Ukraine relocate to other European countries.
