




#### Mission

## **Executive Summary**

2021 witnessed a new normal with the continuation of the COVID19 pandemic. The pandemic heightened the need for our communication strategy to ensure the effective delivery of EASPD messages and member connection via online channels of communication with the continued absence of in-person events until later in 2021.

As a way to understand better these changes and how to adapt to them EASPD held 2 events under the Communications Network. The in-person event in Brussels talked about COVID19 and its impact on communications, the webinar later in the year focused on fundraising online.


Furthermore, we ran 2 social media campaigns throughout 2021. The first, #EASPD25 was created to celebrate 25 years of EASPD. Our second campaign started in November and aimed to highlight the innovative practices of our members and our first Innovation Awards, which was launched to coincide with the anniversary of EASPD. Furthermore, we witnessed a growth in our social media pages and subscriptions to our newsletter.

We published 13 press releases and 22 newsletters during the course of the year. Being the year of growth and change for us, 2021 brought forward a new identity for EASPD. Our new website newsletters, social media and video updates continued to keep our members and external partners updated on the latest news, policy developments, events, publications and innovative practices related to our sector.

## **EASPD Websites**

The EASPD website underwent a makeover during 2021. After 25 years of being on the road, we decided to pave the way for a newer representation of EASPD. Our website is the central element of our communications. All news articles, videos, policy papers and any updates on EU news regarding the disability sector can be found on our website. Along with news of EASPD's activities, member new and project updates, as well as further information on upcoming conferences and events. The EASPD website had 13,949 page views in 2021. Of these 88.5% were new page visitor and 11.5% were returning visitors.




Proportion of new and returning users to www.easpd.eu

#### **D-LOT WEBSITE E-LEARNING HUB**

EASPD's e-learning Hub provides tools, learning materials, advice and guidance about how to develop and sustain high quality support services for persons with disabilities. The learning platform is available for everyone wishing to offer or acquire new understanding/new skills and expertise in community-based services that can fuel the real change in the adoption of the social model of disability.

In 2021 the website expanded with an additional 254 people registering to the platform (a 100% increase on 2018). 2 new Massive Online Open Courses (MOOC) for the BEYOND and a4i projects. With a total of 2291 log ins.



**EASPD** Initiatives

2021 was an extremely special year for EASPD as we finished 25 years of being in service. We carried out a few initiatives that helped us in looking back at our work alongside paving the way forward.


## EASPD COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK



EASPD's Communications Network was created in 2018 as an attempt to gather best practices in communications among our member organisations. The Network aims to promote the exchange of expertise, experience and knowledge to support the communication activities of our members. 17 participants joined.

In October 2021, EASPD's
Communication Network met in Brussels
to attend the workshop, 'Communicating
effectively post COVID-19'to explore how
we can maximise the impact of our
communication activities post COVID-19.
15 participants joined the webinar.

The second meet up was virtual, held in December 2021, where the network of communications officers got together to better understand the world of online fundraising and how non-profit organisations can benefit from tools available online to raise funds through EASPD's Online fundraising webinar.

To celebrate EASPD's 25th Anniversary, and to highlight the work of our members, EASPD launched the first edition of its Innovation Awards. Starting the campaign November social media on our **EASPD** channels. showcased all submissions of best practices carried out our member organisations. published 6 posts on Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn.



The Innovation Awards posts were shared by a total of 26 people and 124 likes. These posts received a lot of engagement mainly from our members.

#### The final step of our transformation





2021 was a year of getting comfortable with the new normal.

Our promotion of the rights of persons with disabilities through the provision of high-quality support services, continued in 2021. EASPD's communication work has aimed to support this goal and increase the visibility of the sector at a European, as well as international level.

As we adapted to the new normal, we hosted our first in-person conference since the pandemic, giving our members and various speakers a platform to express their views.

In 2021 EASPD widely communicated on the new Strategy for the Rights of Persons with Disabilities 2021-2030. Disseminating our own position on it along with ways in which we can implement this strategy was central to our communications work. We also focused on the EU care strategy and how we as an umbrella organisation can help implement this by publishing a position paper on this topic.
