### **Good news from the European Commission!**

ENTELIS project selected for funding. **“ENTELIS - European Network for Technology Enhanced Learning in an Inclusive Society”**

The good news comes from Brussels in the form of an acceptance letter of the ENTELIS proposal that was submitted under the Lifelong Learning Programme. The project aims at creating a sustainable network of organisations working for the systematic development of PCT competence of persons with disability. The project sees, among others, the involvement as partners of EASPD, AAATE -the Association for the Advancement of Assistive technology in Europe- and EVBB - a European network of Vocational Training providers-. Although there is a core consortium, the project is focused on the involvement of many stakeholder organisations, which will mainly be recruited via the three European networks, in research and seminars. Methodologies and strategies for end user empowerment will be identified and analysed, leading to the design of future scenarios and a roadmap. Partners and associate partners in the US and other continents will give the project a global flavour. The 3 year project started this year on the first of January and will finish end of 2016.
