ALDO : Adults with a Learning Disability – Observatory of best practices

- Funded with the support of the Lifelong Learning Programme of the European Commission
- KA4 project on dissemination and exploitation of results
- Time frame : from January 2014 to December 2015
- Project n° 543065-LLP-1-2013-1-IE-KA4-KA4MP





Recycling of successful ideas and methods

- Identify innovative best practice approaches
- Encourage the use of ICT in the education for people with disabilities
- Support tutors and trainers working with adults with a disability
- Foster discussions among education staff from different countries on how to build an inclusive education system



➔ 16 methods and/or ideas were selected in each country around 4 thematic areas:

- Access to information and knowledge
- Learning and teaching environment
- Communication and interaction
- Administrative procedures

➔ Following a questionnaire filled by the project coordinators and the ALDO partners, 84 methods/ideas were selected as potential best practices



Assessment Group in each partner country

- A team of 8 experts from each partner country, outside of the partnership
- Assessed independently all potential best practices on issues of
 - clarity,
 - credibility,
 - contribution to the field
 - attractiveness to users



Teacher/trainer toolkit

- Each potential best practice is accompanied by tips and recommendations on how to implement it and what skills are needed to use it
