

Study-visit in 2 schools in Camden, London: Netley Primary school with Woodlands Resource Center and Torriano Primary school.



Participants engage in classroom visits and observations. Furthermore they can have a dialogue with teachers, students and parents.

After each visit we have reflection time.

The focus of the visits:

- Dealing with diversity (e.g. multilingualism, cultural diversity, diversity in learning) and using diversity to enhance learning of children and educators.
- The curriculum, with goals on global citizenship and philosophy with children
- The work of the resource center and how collaboration between special education and the mainstream school happens to in favor of inclusion.
- The collaboration with parents, families and the community.
- The use of data, e.g. for inspection.

Price: 750 € (2 nights B&B in hotel near Eurostar station, Oystercard with 1day travel, visits of the schools, 2 lunches at school)

Dates: Thursday February 9th 2017 and Friday February 10th 2017.

Participants with a KA1-grant can ask for 2 travel days on Wednesday February 8th 2017 and Friday February 11th 2017.
